I. Glorifying God

Read 1 Corinthians 10:31. Based on this verse, what should Christians consider as they go about “doing” in their lives?

What does it mean to “bring glory” to God?

What attributes of God do you bring Him honour and praise for? What things has God done and is God doing that cause you to glorify God?

Read 1 Chronicles 16:28-29. According to these verses, what response flows out of our glorifying God? How does this tie in to Romans 12:1?

God is great and God is good but how does God show the depth of His love for us? Note 1 John 4:9-10.

II. Created by God

What does Genesis 1:27 and Revelation 4:11 tell us about God?

What about the creation of mankind and the world and the wonderful complexity of both cause us to glorify God?

Read Psalm 139:13-16. How does knowing that God formed you personally and specifically impact how you view the relationship you have with God?

What does Psalm 139:16 tell us about God’s plan and will for our lives?

III. Re-Created by God

What does sin do to us as a creation of God? Why do we need to be re-created?

How is this new re-creation described in 2 Corinthians 5:17?

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 talks about Christians being purchased. What was the purchase price? What are the implications of this?

What are some ways we can honour God with our body?

IV. Question #6 — Does it glorify God?

What is the greatest threat to God being given the glory in our lives?

Why does God deserve to be glorified by how we live?

How do many of us as Christians try to limit the reach of Question #6 in our lives?

What is the value of applying these six Questions to the decisions and choices of our lives? What is the ultimate goal for our lives as Christians?
