#### I. The Invitation of Jesus

Read Revelation 3:20. What are the issues of the Laodicean church?

This passage is not about salvation because it is written to Christians in Laodicea. What is the message to these believers? Note Revelation 3:19

What does it mean when someone is “knocking at the door” of our house?

Why does Jesus stand at the door and knock? What is His intention?

Who do people think Jesus is?

Who does Jesus know that He is?

If we see “opening the door” as a call to surrender our lives to Jesus as Lord, why is that so hard for us to do?

How does Ephesians 4:22-24 describe the change Jesus brings to us?

What does Revelation 3:20 tell us that Jesus will do if we open the door?

How would you describe an intimate relationship with Jesus?

#### II. Walking with Jesus

Read Joshua 1:7-9. What was happening in the life of the people of God and in the life of Joshua?

What were Joshua and the people of God to obey in Joshua 1:7? How is this obedience defined in this verse?

What do you think it means to turn to the right or left from God's Word?

What does 2 Timothy 3:16-17 tell us that God's Word will do for us?

What does Joshua 1:8 tell us to do with the Word of God?

What is the end result of focusing on God's Word?

Does being prosperous and successful actually mean that we will get a lot of money and material things?

What do the following verses tell us about what God will bring into our lives? John 8:12, John 10:10, Philippians 1:6

What does the front door of your house give Jesus access to in your life?
